

Check Video on Conjunctions of D1 - Vimshottari Dasha. Based on that, decide the planet if conjoined / in parivartana. This is the *Dasa Lord* from now on.

Exceptions:

1. **Nodes:** In case of nodes (Rahu/Ketu) in the above parivartana or conjunction - many times the exchange is happening only when the planet(s) is exalted / debilitated. Otherwise, Nodes are giving their results and also the lord of the Rasi in which they are placed in D1.
2. **Degrees:** If there are planets on same degree (<1 degree difference) as lagna degree in any Rasi - they do not exchange results with any planet.
3. If planets are on same nakshatra & pada - most likely results will be interchanged
4. Results are interchanged, if planets are exalted / debilitated / own sign etc.

Analysis Steps:

Step	Topic	Description
1	Dasa Lord - Nakshatra Theme	Read the Nakshatra theme of the Dasa Lord. Refer website for nakshatra traits etc. Check what lords it is disposing. Watch the whole 2 hour Nakshatra videos, if you are a beginner.
2	Dasa Lord - Nava Durga Theme	Read Nava Durgas of my lectures in Telugu / Shubham Alock.
3	Dasa Lord - Amsa Pada Theme	Read Pada Name of the Nakshatra it is in. Read Pada name Characteristics.
4	Quick Check: Health Issues for self or relatives in a dasa.	<p>1. Refer D1 and note down the <i>houses and lords</i> of self-lagna and relatives - father, mother, siblings, spouse etc.</p> <p>2. In D9, if the dasa lord is placed in 8th/12th from the above - health issues to that particular relationship. 8th shows persistent issues or diseases making lifestyle changes later, 12th shows an accident / a simple surgery / fracture etc that involves a couple of visits affecting an antardasa. Do not forget parivartanas in D9.</p> <p>3. Make D9 placement as lagna- check the badhaka lord. It's conjunction in D9 with self / relatives</p>

Step	Topic	Description

5	Get Ready with Navamsa	1. Note the Rashi placement of the dasa lord. Call this as <i>Dasa Lagna (DL)</i> . 2. Open D-9 and check the dasa lord Navamsa sign(Rashi). 3. There will be two houses ruled by this lord. For Cancer / Leo - Take Sun and Moon both as rulers.
6	Dasa Lord Theme	1. Count the houses that are made by N1 and N2 from DL. 2. Check <i>Combos</i> . Decipher results. Be mindful of parivartanas in D9.
7	What exalts in the sign where the dasa lord is placed in D9?	1. Be mindful of parivartanas in D9. 2. Check the placement of dasa lord in D9. 3. Check lord of which houses of D1 exalts there. 4. They gain strength, courage, domination. Or native's life changes for accommodating that relative's elevation. 5. If this connects to a quadrant from D9 lagna - it affects the life of the native very much.
8	What debilitates in the sign where the dasa lord is placed in D9?	1. Be mindful of parivartanas in D9. 2. Check the placement of dasa lord in D9. 3. Check lord of which houses of D1 exalts there. 4. They lose strength / become timid / will be dominated. Or native's life changes for accommodating that relative's demotion / bad. 5. If this connects to a quadrant from D9 lagna - this affects the native very much.
9	Self Theme	Check the houses made by N1 and N2 combos from Rasi Thulya Navamsa. Also add it from Lagna lord of D-1 and Navamsa Lagna.
10	Others Theme	1. Check N1 and N2 combos from lords and houses of <i>Others</i> of D1.
